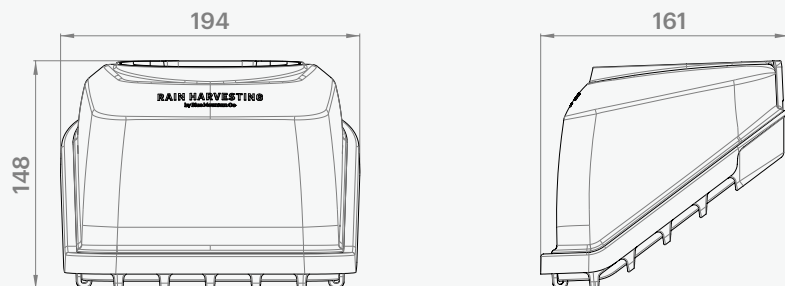

## Installation and Specification Guide

### PRODUCT DETAILS

Keeping leaves, mosquitoes and other insects out of your downpipe while maximising the amount of rainwater collected, The Hood Upgrade reduces contamination and captures more rainwater for your Leaf Eater Advanced rain head.

**RHAC10** The Hood Upgrade for Leaf Eater Advanced (Hood and screen only, rain head body not included)

- The Hood minimises splashing so you capture as much water as possible
- 0.955mm stainless steel mosquito proof screen prevents pests from getting into your downpipes
- Designed to fit straight onto your existing Leaf Eater Advanced rain head without the need for fasteners

- Multi fit hood inlet allows for 90mm, 100mm, 3" and 4" pipe

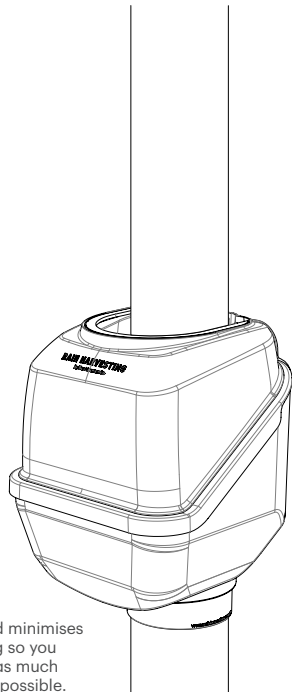
## WHAT'S IN THE BOX?

- The Hood Upgrade Cover
- The Hood Upgrade Screen

## TOOLS/MATERIALS YOU MAY REQUIRE

- Tape measure
- Marker pen
- Saw
- Screws
- Screwdriver or drill
- Solvent cement glue

## HOW IT WORKS



The Hood minimises splashing so you capture as much water as possible.



The Hood can be easily removed for maintenance.

## THE HOOD UPGRADE INSTALLATION

1. Remove and discard your Leaf Eater Advanced screen.
2. Attach The Hood screen to the Leaf Eater Advanced body, making sure the screen is fully seated all the way around and flush with the body.
3. Ensure your inlet pipe is cut to sit at least 20mm below the top surface of The Hood cover.
4. If your inlet pipe is 100mm or 4", you will need to cut away the multi fit inlet so your inlet pipe can fit inside.
5. Slide the cover up your inlet pipe and fit to the screen, making sure that the skirt around the edge is fully seated in the corresponding channel on the screen.

## MAINTENANCE

1. Slide The Hood cover up your inlet pipe and remove The Hood screen.
2. With the screen removed, either brush off or wash the debris from the screen.
3. Reinsert the screen to the Leaf eater Advanced body, making sure the screen is fully seated all the way around and flush with the body.
4. Reinstall the cover, making sure that the skirt around the edge is fully seated in the corresponding channel on the screen.
